

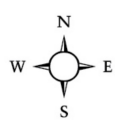

TRAILS

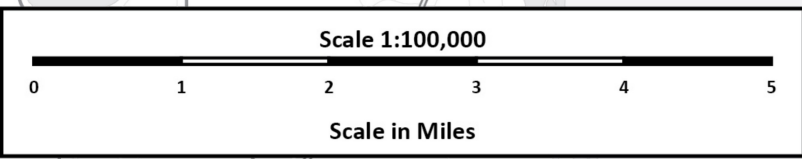
- Paved State Trail

Suggested Routes with Rest Stops Offered



HIKERS:
From the Solanus Friary:
Follow the Blue dots around Work Zone...
1. West on Jessamine Ave.
2. Right onto Arkwright North
3. Straight across Maryland
4. Quick Right onto Brainerd (angles Northwest)
5. Left onto Edgerton (North)
6. Caution: the sidewalk is missing for 2 blocks on Edgerton from Larpenteur to the Gateway trail.
7. Right onto the Gateway Trail!

HIKERS:
From the Coldwater Stop at Neal:
Follow the Blue dots to St. Michael's...
1. Take Neal Ave. South (sidewalk)
2. Left onto Boutwell
3. Left onto Myrtle East (aka 75th)
4. Right onto Greeley South
5. Pass Nelson's Ice Cream (or stop! ;-)
6. Continue down Greeley South
7. Left onto Pine
8. Right onto 3rd
9. Left into Church driveway, enter Rear Church doors

Use caution: no sidewalk across lake, but wide shoulder.

HIKERS:
Decision point at Jamaca Ave. stop...
A) stay on the blue Gateway & Browns Creek Trail to Coldwater Stop/Neal Ave. (in shade) OR...
B) leave the Gateway and take the sidewalk south to 75th Avenue/County 12. (see the RED DOTS) saves 0.75 mi/20 min. (full sun!)
